

GRANTIAU DAN ARWEINIAD POBL IFANC 2022-2023

Meini Prawf & Nodiadau Canllaw

1. Nod

Nod cynllun Grantiau Dan Arweiniad Pobl Ifanc yw cefnogi ystod o brosiectau a gweithgareddau bychan GWIRFODDOLI POBL IFANC wedi eu harwain a'u gweithredu gan bobl ifanc. Mi fydd y ceisiadau yn cael eu dethol a'u cymeradwyo gan banel o bobl ifanc rhwng 14 a 25 oed.

2. CYMHWYSTER

Petai mudiadau yn cael eu hariannu dylent:

- Fod â chyfrif banc, yn enw'r mudiad, sydd angen o leiaf ddau lofnod (neu fod mewn partneriaeth â sefydliad sydd â chyfrif banc)

Os ydych yn sefydliad cyfansoddol, atodwch gopi i'ch cais pan fyddwch yn ei gyflwyno. Rydym yn derbyn ceisiadau gan grwpiau o bobl ifanc heb eu sefydlu ar yr amod eu bod yn barod i weithio gyda ni i ddatblygu eu strwythur llywodraethu er mwyn rheoli'r grant yn effeithiol.

3. BETH ALL GAEL EI ARIANNU?

Bydd y cynllun Grantiau Dan Arweiniad Pobl Ifanc yn ystyried ariannu prosiectau neu digwyddiadau untro, sydd yn darparu CYFLEOEDD GWIRFODDOLI gyda ystod amrywiol o bobl ifanc (14 i 25 oed). Mae pob gweithgaredd gwirfoddoli ieuentid yn ymwneud â phobl ifanc rhwng 14 a 25 oed yn gymwys i wneud cais; serch hynny, rhoddir blaenoriaeth i'r canlynol:

- Gweld gwirfoddoli o fudd i'r gwirfoddolwr unigol ac i gymuned ehangach Ceredigion
- O fantais i bobl ifanc rhwng 14 a 25 oed o fewn y mudiad
- Pobl ifanc ag anabledd dysgu neu anabledd corfforol sydd yn byw yng Ngheredigion
- Pobl ifanc o Gymunedau Difreintiedig er enghraifft Cymunedau Pobl Dduon, Asiaidd neu Leiafrifoedd Ethnig o fewn Ceredigion.

4. AM FAINT O ARIAN Y GELLIR GWNEUD CAIS?

- Bydd ceisiadau hyd at **£1000** yn cael eu hystyried am brosiectau untro (unigryw) gyda phrif ffocws ar ieuentid.
- Dylid gwario'r arian a dderbyniwyd yn ôl y gyllideb yr ydych wedi paratoi yn eich cais a dylid gwario'r holl arian erbyn **3 Iain Mawrth 2023**.
- Rhaid ad-dalu unrhyw arian sydd heb ei wario erbyn y dyddiad uchod i CAVO.
- Gall prosiectau blaenorol Grantiau Dan Arweiniad Pobl Ifanc ail-geisio am gyllid eleni unwaith fydd prosiectau blaenorol wedi'u cwblhau ac ar yn amod ei fod yn brosiect gwahanol.

5. Y BROSES O WNEUD CAIS

- Gellir cyflwyno ceisiadau naill ai mewn fformat ysgrifenedig neu weledol (e.e. fideo, cyflwyniad, lluniau, recordiad llais) neu gyfuniad o'r ddau. Rhaid anfon ceisiadau at y Swyddog Gwirfoddoli yn CAVO drwy e-bost neu drwy'r post ynghyd â chyfansoddiad eich sefydliad.
- Y dyddiad cau ar gyfer ceisiadau yw'r **30^{ain} o Tachwedd 2022**
- Gan mai swm cyfyngedig sydd ar gael, ni fydd bob cais a dderbynnir yn cael ei gefnogi ac fe fydd ceisiadau yn cael eu blaenoriaethu. Byddwn yn gwneud ein gorau i gyfeirio prosiectau aflwyddiannus at gyllidwyr eraill. Fe alla rhai ceisiadau gael eu cyllido'n rhannol.

6. ASESU

- Ystyrir ceisiadau gan 'banel grantiau' o bobl ifanc rhwng 14 a 25 oed, sy'n cynrychioli pobl ifanc yng Ngheredigion.
- Mae pob penderfyniad yn derfynol, ac fel y gwêl y Panel Grantiau Dan Arweiniad
- Efallai bydd y panel ieuentid yn gwahodd yr ymgeiswyr i gyfarfod er mwyn cael rhagor o fanylion am y prosiect ac i sicrhau bod y rhai ifanc yn cymryd rhan allweddol ac yn cwrdd ag amcanion y prosiect.

7. MONITRO A GWERTHUSO

Disgwylir i bob ymgeisydd llwyddiannus gyflwyno adroddiad monitro ar eu prosiectau i gydymffurfio â gofynion Cyngor Gweithredu Gwirfoddol Cymru (WCVA) mewn perthynas â Grant Dan Arweiniad Pobl Ifanc. Gall hyn gynnwys ymweliadau gan staff CAVO lle bo hynny'n briodol.

YOUTH LED GRANTS 2022 -2023 Criteria & Guidance Notes

1. Aim

The aim of the Youth Led Grants scheme is to support a range of small youth volunteering projects and activities, led and carried out by young people, with applications selected and recommended by a panel of young people aged 14-25.

2. ELIGIBILITY

If organisations are funded they should:

- Have a bank account, in the name of the organisation, which requires at least two signatures (or in partnership with an organisation with a bank account)

If you are a constituted organisation, please attach a copy to your application when you submit it. We do accept applications from unconstituted groups of young people provided they are willing to work with us to develop their governance for the purpose of effectively managing the grant.

3. WHAT CAN BE FUNDED?

The Youth Led Grants scheme will consider funding projects or one/off events that deliver VOLUNTEERING OPPORTUNITIES with and for a diverse range of young people (aged 14-25). All youth volunteering activities involving young people between 14-25 are eligible to apply; however, priority will be given to the following:

- See volunteering to be a benefit to the individual volunteer and the wider community of Ceredigion
- Benefit young people between 14-25 years old within the organisation
- Young People with a physical or learning disability and living in Ceredigion
- Young People from Disadvantaged Communities such as Black, Asian & Minority Ethnic Communities within Ceredigion.

4. HOW MUCH CAN YOU APPLY FOR?

- Requests up to **£1000** will be considered for nonrecurring (one off) projects with a key youth focus.
- All funding received must be spent according to the budget you have drawn up in your application and all funding must be spent by **31st March 2023**.
- Any funding not spent by the date above must be repaid to CAVO.
- Previous Youth Led Grant funded projects can reapply for this year's GwirVol funding once previous grant projects have been completed and providing it is a separate project.

5. APPLICATION PROCESS

- Applications can be submitted in either written or visual formats (e.g. video, presentation, photos, voice recording) or a combination of the two. Applications must be sent to the Volunteering Officer at CAVO via email or post alongside the constitution for your organisation.
- The closing date for applications is **30th November 2022**
- As funding is limited, not all applications received will be supported and applications will be prioritised. We will try our utmost to signpost unsuccessful applications to other funders. Some applications may be partly funded.

6. APPLICATION ASSESSMENT

- Applications will be considered by a 'grants panel' made up of young people aged 14-25 years old, representing young people in Ceredigion.
- All decisions are final and at the discretion of the Youth Led Grants Panel
- The youth panel may invite the applicants into a meeting to go into more details about the project and to ensure that there is a high level of youth involvement, and it meets the aims of the funding.

7. MONITORING AND EVALUATION

All successful applicants will be expected to provide monitoring reports on their projects in line with the requirements of Wales Council for Voluntary Action (WCVA) in relation to the Youth Led Grant. This may include visits from CAVO staff where appropriate.
